

Regulations

1. Admission and Acceptance

The European EXPP Summit is a congress focusing on E-Invoicing and EBPP (Electronic Bill Presentment and Payment). Services and products as specified by the organiser are allowed to be exhibited. By signing the booking form the sponsor agrees that these terms and conditions are binding on him and his employees or agents. They will receive an email from the organiser to confirm his booking.

2. Date and Venue

The European EXPP Summit will take place in Munich, Germany, at the Hilton Munich Park hotel, October 11 to 12, 2010.

3. Booth Allocation

Special booth location requests will be considered wherever possible but cannot be accepted as conditional for participation as an exhibitor.

4. Booth Space

Booth space means clear floor space. The following exhibition packages can be chosen:

- Partner Package: 2 metres (wide) x 3 metres (long)
- Business Package: 2 metres (wide) x 3 metres (long)
- Economy Package: 2 metres (wide) x 2 metres (long)

5. Booth Construction

The exhibitor receives a ready-to-use booth, which will be provided by the organiser/ the official booth constructor of the EXPP Summit.

6. Advertising

Each sponsoring package includes one entry of the company portrait on the event's website, one entry in the category "Who's Who" for one year, as well as one entry in the event brochure.

7. Co-Exhibitors

Participation of co-exhibitors requires special registration as well as confirmation by the organiser. Co-exhibitors appear at the booth of the main-exhibitor. The exhibition fee will be paid by the main exhibitor.

8. Vendor Speech

Presentations within the official programme held by solution or service providers are strictly limited to a booking of the package "Vendor Speech". Please respect that we consider mainly applications with complementary speeches.

9. Terms of Payment

All prices are exclusive of the local value-added tax. Payments will be made after registration and must be received by March 31, 2010. Payments not made in due time may result in cancellation of your bookings. Postponed payments may result in a temporary removal of sponsors' profile in our marketing communication without any right for compensation.

10. Attractions and Special Advertising (Shows, Music, Film, etc.)

Plans for demonstrations and attractions at the booth must be submitted to the organiser in writing and in good time for authorisation. Such events may not interfere, visually or acoustically, with booth neighbours' presentations. Neither may they impede visitors from circulating in the aisles. It should be especially noted that the area in front of the booth may not be occupied by such events, nor may the area outside the booth space be used in any way for advertising purposes. The distribution of promotional material outside the booth space is strictly prohibited without written authorisation. Exhibitors who infringe rules of fair competition may, in blatant cases and in the interests of the exhibition as a whole, be excluded from the exhibition with immediate effect.

11. Buildup and Dismantling

Dates for the buildup and dismantling of the booths will be announced in good time by the organiser. These dates must be adhered to by the exhibitor.

12. Liability

The organiser is neither liable for any equipment nor accepts responsibility for them.

13. Withdrawal from the Booking

If the sponsor withdraws from the booking after it has been concluded, the following charges payable by the sponsor to the organiser are applicable:

- 25 percent of the amount of the sponsoring package in the case of withdrawal before May 14, 2010
- 50 percent of the amount of the sponsoring package in the case of withdrawal from May 14 to August 13, 2010
- 100 percent of the amount of the sponsoring package in the case of withdrawal after August 13, 2010

14. Abandonment of Realisation

In the event of compelling grounds or force majeure, the organiser is entitled to postpone, curtail, extend or cancel the European EXPP Summit. In such a case, the sponsor is entitled to neither withdrawal nor compensation. If unforeseen political or economic circumstances, industry problems or force majeure make it impossible to hold the European EXPP Summit, the organiser undertakes to refund the sponsor's payments less costs already incurred.

15. Applicable Law and Place of Jurisdiction

All legal relationships between the sponsor and the organiser are subject to Swiss law. The organiser's domicile is expressly agreed as the place of jurisdiction.

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
